Paediatric update in Kerang

Tonight, Paediatrician Dr Andy Lovett will present a Paediatrics Update to health professionals at the Royal Hotel, Kerang.

Dr Lovett now consults at the Kerang Medical Clinic bimonthly and on the alternate month offers telehealth consults from his consulting rooms in Bendigo.

Dr Lovett is the Director of Paediatrics at Bendigo Health and also works in Shepparton and Echuca. He is Chair of the Victorian State Committee (Paediatrics) within the Royal Australasian College of Physicians and is a Director of Physician Education within the college.

He has had a longstanding interest in Australia's specialist regional paediatric workforce and established the Victorian Rural Child Health Training Module - designed for advanced trainees in general paediatrics - in 2006, which became national.

At tonight's event, hosted by Murray PHN, Dr Lovett will discuss Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), childhood constipation and faecal loading, the irritable and refluxing infant and cover the benefits of telehealth.
