Overview

GPs have an important role in detection, diagnosis and management of vulval conditions. This talk will outline how GPs can distinguish vulval dermatoses and abnormal lesions from normal vulval anatomy. The presenters will describe the technique of vulval biopsy and the management of common vulval conditions including lichen sclerosus, vulval dermatitis and vulvodynia.

- Explain the important steps in performing a vulval biopsy
- Manage common vulval conditions including lichen sclerosus and vulval dermatitis, including appropriate referral
