Overview

Be introduced to the role of comprehensive lung function testing, and tour the new Mildura respiratory lung function laboratory facilities.

Learning outcomes

1. Introduction to state of the art lung function laboratory service in Mildura.
2. Understand the role of lung function testing beyond spirometry such as diffusing capacity and body pletysmography (lung volumes) assessment.
3. Understand the role of bronchoprovocation testing (Mannitol challenge).
4. Understand the role of lung function testing to diagnose lung disease.
5. Understand the role of lung function testing to measure effects of occupational or environment exposure to dust and fumes.
6. Understand the role of lung function testing to determine beneficial or negative effects of therapy such as respiratory medications, chemotherapy, radiotherapy or pulmonary rehabilitation.
7. Understand the role of lung function testing to assess risk for surgical procedures such as lobectomy, pneumonectomy and upper abdominal procedures.
