



## Background

Murray HealthPathways brings together local experts to research and agree on best practice care and localised referral options. It is a web based portal that stores evidence-based pathways for a range of health conditions. Murray HealthPathways is designed to be used at the point of care, primarily for general practitioners, but will also be available to specialists, nurses, allied health and other health professionals in the Murray PHN catchment.

The goal of Murray HealthPathways is to drive improvement in the coordination and management of patient care. Murray PHN is working steadily with health providers and services to localise HealthPathways with the aim of launching the website on 9 November 2016.

## Accessing Murray HealthPathways

[Murray HealthPathways](#) is a free resource for all public and private health professionals within the Murray PHN catchment.

Murray PHN will set up a unique Murray HealthPathways login for your practice or health service. With our automatic login, health professionals at your practice or health service can access Murray HealthPathways via a simple link.

Please complete the automatic login request on page two with details of your IP address and we will do the rest.

GP practices using the Pen CS CAT Plus tool will have a Murray HealthPathways link embedded in Top Bar.

## Benefits of automatic login

An automatic login using your IP address makes your access to Murray HealthPathways faster and easier and will provide you with useful reports from the HealthPathways team on the clinical conditions or referral information your health professionals are searching for. This, in turn, will inform our understanding of primary health within the Murray PHN catchment area and identify opportunities for ongoing improvements. It will also help us provide health professionals with the best web based, localised HealthPathways tool in the region.

## Collection of Murray HealthPathways activity information

Activity information collected will include the frequency of use of HealthPathways. The identification of the most popular pathways, the length of time spent on particular pathways and the search terms used will all help us prioritise pathway development. Information collected will be at a practice or health service level only and will not identify individual health professionals, nor any patient related information.

## How can I find my IP Address?

An IP address (internet protocol address) is used for communication between computer systems over the internet. Individual users are not identified.
