## Overview

The Program of Experience in the Palliative Approach (PEPA) aims to enhance the capacity of health and aged care professionals to deliver a palliative approach to care through a range of evidence based education strategies. The Palliative Care Section of the Commonwealth Department of Health has provided funding to undertake national targeted palliative care education sessions to General Practitioners (GPs) through the Primary Health Networks.

## Learning outcomes

- Identify key strategies for recognising individuals in the general practice setting who may be approaching the end of life.
- Implement strategies for communication with patients and families about prognosis, goals and preferences of care.
- Describe the principles of end of life care, including assessment and management of pain and other common symptoms.
- Use resources that support general practitioners to provide end of life care.
- Investigate self-care strategies to effectively manage personal issues related to work in this field.
